## EYFS policy

Emmer green after school club is committed to meeting the requirements of the statutory of framework for the early years foundation stage 2017 (EYFS).

EYFS applies to children from birth through to reception year age 5.

The Ethos of our Club is that children have a relaxing, safe and fun environment where they can socialise with children from a wide range of ages and express and explore their own interests. The children are able to decide how they occupy their time with us choosing from a range of adult and child lead activities daily, toys & equipment.

At EGASC our designated EYFS co-ordinators at the club are: Stacie Smith (Club Manager), Emma Boswell (Deputy Manager) and Michelle Smith (Deputy Manager) They are responsible for:

- Identifying EYFS children before they start at the club and informing other staff. Each child is assigned a Key person and offered a taster/settling session.
- Liaising with parents to discuss what the club offers and agree on what kind of support parents expect for their child
- Gaining parental consent to share information with the primary school where necessary.
- Liaising with the child's teacher to gain daily feedback/ handover at collection time.
- Making sure that the club offers activities and equipment to contribute to the learning and development of each child.
